

Code of conduct for Volunteers

This policy is intended to ensure good practice in the involvement of volunteers in Tough Enough To Care's work.

As a volunteer for Tough Enough To Care we ask you:

- Implement our Safeguarding policy and procedures
- Report any concerns about or allegations of abuse or poor practice to our Safeguarding Officer
- ✓ Listen to any concerns that other volunteers may have
- ✓ Do not engage in any behaviour that constitutes any form of abuse
- Respect your position of trust and maintain appropriate boundaries and relationships
- ✓ Do not act in a manner that could bring Tough Enough To Care into disrepute
- Respect service users and guests trust and rights whilst being honest and open with them
- ✓ Do not discriminate against anyone, regardless of age, gender, race, sexual orientation, religion or culture
- ✓ Use constructive and positive methods of developing skills, without humiliating or harming any attendee's of our meetings and/or events
- Challenge and address appropriately instances of poor, negative, aggressive or bullying behaviour
- ✓ Help make any Tough Enough To Care event or meeting a friendly and welcoming place to be
- Strive to uphold the reputation of the organisation and those who work in it when speaking as a private citizen
- ✓ Do not accept personal gifts or money
- Ensure all Tough Enough To Care donations and funds are processed accurately, honestly and appropriately
